ORDINANCE 2024-1

Ordinance Establishing Handicapped Parking Spaces at 14 Argyle Place, 34 Highland Avenue, 100 Chestnut Street, and 177 Windsor Street

WHEREAS, the Police Department has reported that the establishment of restricted parking zones in front of the residences hereinafter set forth are not otherwise prohibited and the permitting thereof would not interfere with the normal flow of traffic; now, therefore, be it

ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kearny, Hudson County, New Jersey that:

1. A restricted parking zone be and hereby is established in front of the following residences, which are occupied by handicapped persons, at the locations specified:

<u>Residence</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Handicapped Person</u>
14 Argyle Place	Beginning at a point 170 feet North of the Northeast curb line of Argyle Place and Midland Avenue to a point 22 feet North thereof	Anna Macarthur
34 Highland Avenue	Beginning at a point 122 feet South of the Southeast curb line of Highland Avenue and Woodland Avenue to a point 22 feet South thereof	Ronald Kelly
177 Windsor Street	Beginning at a point 177 feet South of the Southwest curb line of Windsor Street and Liberty Street to a point 22 feet South thereof	Juan Cruz
100 Chestnut Street	Beginning at a point 211 feet South of the Southeast curb line of Hoyt Street and Chestnut Street to a point 22 feet South thereof	Maria Oliveira

2. No zone shall be established, however, unless a windshield placard or wheelchair symbol license plates have been issued for a vehicle owned by the handicapped person, or by another occupant of the residence who is a member of the immediate family of the handicapped person, by the Division of Motor Vehicles pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-204.

3. No other vehicle shall be permitted to park in the designated space.


4. A sign, as prescribed by N.J.S.A. 39:4-198, shall be placed at the place where this ordinance is effective. Appropriate signs, type R 7/8 should be installed.


