ORDINANCE 2024-10

Ordinance Establishing Handicapped Parking Spaces at 221 Oakwood Avenue, 653 Chestnut Street and 341 Davis Avenue

WHEREAS, the Police Department has reported that the establishment of restricted parking zones in front of the residences hereinafter set forth is not otherwise prohibited and the permitting thereof would not interfere with the normal flow of traffic; now, therefore, be it

ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kearny, Hudson County, New Jersey that:

1. A restricted parking zone be and hereby is established in front of the following residences, which are occupied by a handicapped person, at the location specified:

<u>Residence</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Handicapped Person</u>
221 Oakwood Avenue	Beginning at a point 70 Feet West of the Northwest curb line of Schuyler Avenue and Oakwood Avenue to a point 22 feet East thereof	John Tarazona
653 Chestnut Street	Beginning at a point 131 Feet North of the Northwest curb line of Chestnut Street and Laurel Avenue to a point 22 feet South thereof	Andrea Rodriquez
341 Davis Avenue	Beginning at a point 113 Feet North of the Northwest curb line of Davis Avenue and Quincy Avenue to a point 22 feet North thereof	William Lyman

2. No zone shall be established, however, unless a windshield placard or wheelchair symbol license plates have been issued for a vehicle owned by the handicapped person, or by another occupant of the residence who is a member of the immediate family of the handicapped person, by the Division of Motor Vehicles pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-204.

3. No other vehicle shall be permitted to park in the designated space.


4. A sign, as prescribed by N.J.S.A. 39:4-198, shall be placed at the place where this ordinance is effective. Appropriate signs, type R 7/8 should be installed.


