ORDINANCE 2024-14

Ordinance Establishing Handicapped Parking Space at 496 Elm Street

WHEREAS, the Police Department has reported that the establishment of a restricted parking zone in front of the residence hereinafter set forth is not otherwise prohibited and the permitting thereof would not interfere with the normal flow of traffic, now, therefore, be it

ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kearny, Hudson County, New Jersey that:

1. A restricted parking zone be and hereby is established in front of the following residence, which is occupied by a handicapped person, at the location specified:

<u>Residence</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Handicapped Person</u>
496 Elm Street	Beginning at a point 175 feet North of the Northeast curb line of Elm Street and Garofalo Place to a point 22 feet South thereof	Adrian Valcarcel

2. No zone shall be established, however, unless a windshield placard or wheelchair symbol license plates have been issued for a vehicle owned by the handicapped person, or by another occupant of the residence who is a member of the immediate family of the handicapped person, by the Division of Motor Vehicles pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-204.
3. No other vehicle shall be permitted to park in the designated space.
4. A sign, as prescribed by N.J.S.A. 39:4-198, shall be placed at the place where this ordinance is effective. Appropriate signs, type R 7/8 should be installed.


