AN ORDINANCE APPROVING ACTIONS OF THE POLICE CHIEF AND RATIFYING A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSFER OF EQUIPMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF KEARNEY, MISSOURI, AND CLAY COUNTY, MISSOURI

WHEREAS, on January 4, 2024 the Police Chief signed a cooperative agreement between the City of Kearney and Clay County, Missouri for three (3) 2016-2019 SUV cages and three (3) dual gun racks; and

WHEREAS, the Kearney Police Department had a need for said cages and gun racks for use in its patrol vehicle fleet; and

WHEREAS, the county transferred three (3) cages for 2016-2019 SUV's and three (3) dual gun racks t to the Kearney Police Department for its use.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF KEARNEY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the actions of the Police Chief executing a cooperative agreement between the City of Kearney and Clay County, Missouri for the transfer of equipment is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the cooperative agreement made and entered into on January 4, 2024, between Clay County, Missouri and Kearney Police Department is hereby ratified and approved. A copy of the agreement shall be attached and considered part of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Kearney and approved by the Mayor.

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the County is in possession of (3) Cages for 2016 – 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks that are no longer being utilized by the County and which the County wishes to provide to the public safety agency for its use;

AND WHEREAS, the **Kearney Police Department** has a need for said (3) Cages for 2016 – 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks to allow the public safety agency to further its mission of serving and protecting the persons and property in its jurisdiction and to help protect the safety of its citizens and employees;

AND WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of entering into a cooperative agreement under \$70.220 RSMo for purpose of allowing the county to provide said (3) Cages for 2016 – 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks to the public safety agency;

AND WHEREAS, the transfer of (3) Cages for 2016 – 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks will mutually benefit both parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein, the parties agree as follows:

- Upon execution of this agreement, County shall transfer this property to the public safety agency
 Cages for 2016 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks.
- 2. The law enforcement agency shall be entitled to utilize said (3) Cages for 2016 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks for its own uses and shall, upon acceptance of the (3) Cages for 2016 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks be the sole owner and be solely responsible for the maintenance, care and use of the (3) Cages for 2016 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks. Upon said transfer, County

shall have no interest or ownership in the (3) Cages for 2016 – 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks. Additionally, law enforcement agency agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Clay County, Missouri and County's agents, employees, office holders, and commissioners for any and all damages occurring as a result of the use of the (3) Cages for 2016 – 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks to any person or property, as well as any and all damages, including reasonable attorney(s') fees and suit costs the County may incur as a result of any training County may provide with regard to the (3) Cages for 2016 – 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks or the public safety agency's acts, omissions or negligence with regard to (3) Cages for 2016 – 2019 SUV's and (3) Dual Gun Racks.

- 3. Effective Date. This cooperative agreement will take effect upon approval of the County Commission and the public safety agency. Each body shall approve and maintain this agreement pursuant to \$70.230, RSMo.
- 4. This writing contains the entire agreement of the parties. No representations were made or relied upon by either party, other than those expressly set forth herein. No agent, employee or other representative of either party is empowered to alter any term of this agreement, unless done in writing and signed by the same officers as have executed this contract.
- 5. *Controlling Law*. The validity, interpretation, and performance of this agreement shall be controlled by and construed under the laws of the State of Missouri.
- 6. Waiver. The failure of either party to this agreement to object to or to take affirmative action with respect to the conduct of the other which is in violation of the terms of this agreement shall not be construed as a waiver of the violation or breach, or any future violation, breach or wrongful conduct.
- 7. *Notices*. All notices pertaining to this agreement shall be in writing and transmitted by either personal hand delivery or through the United States Post Office, certified or registered mail return receipt requested. All notices shall be sent to addresses set forth above for the respective parties, unless either gives written notice of a change of address.
- 8. *Headings*. Headings in this agreement are for convenience only and shall not be used to interpret or construe as provisions.

9. *Binding Effect*. The provisions of this agreement are binding on the parties hereto, their heirs, successors and assigns.
