A local law amending Chapter 30, Police Commission, Board of, of the Code of the Village of Kings Point

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the *(Name of Legislative Body)*

Section 1. Subsection B of §30.2, Establishment; composition, of Chapter 30, Police Commission, Board of, of the Code of the Village of Kings Point, is hereby amended, to read as follows:

“B. The Commission shall consist of not less than three and not more than four members.”

Section 2. Said §30.2 is hereby further amended to add a new subsection C, to read as follows:

“C. Any action taken shall require a majority of the appointed members to the Commission.”

Section 3. The title of § 30-3. Appointments; residency of Chairman, of said chapter is hereby amended to read:

“§ 30-3. Appointments; residency”

Section 4. Subsection C of said § 30-3 of said chapter is hereby amended to read, respectively, as follows:

“C. Not less than two members, which shall include any Board members, shall be residents of the Village.”

Section 5. Said § 30-3 is hereby further amended to add a new subsection d, to read as follows:

“D. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Village Law, two of the Commissioners may reside within the County of Nassau, New York, even though such residence is outside the corporate limits of the Village, if such person has either:

(1) Previously served on the Commission for at least 5 years; or

(2) Has at least 15 years of service as a police officer.

Section 6. § 30-4, Terms; compensation, of said chapter is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§ 30-4. Terms; compensation.

A. The terms of office shall be for five years commencing from the first day of the official year in which they are appointed, even if they are appointed at a later date of that official year.

B. The initial term, or any renewed term, shall be staggered among the commissioners so that each of the commissioners’ terms shall expire at the end of an official year differing from the others.

C. The Commissioners shall serve without compensation.”

Section 7. Effective Date. This local law shall take effect immediately.
