A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KINGSTON, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, REESTABLISHING FEES FOR MUNICIPAL MAINTENANCE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Kingston provides municipal maintenance services within the Municipality of Kingston as necessary and appropriate when properties have been allowed to fall below the standards set forth in Municipal Ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, Kingston Municipal Code Section 108, enacted on October 1, 2012, by Ordinance 2012-5, establishes a Schedule of Municipal Maintenance Fees with regard to necessary maintenance services rendered by the Municipality; and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2012-5, Paragraph No. 5, provides for fee schedules to be amended from time to time by Resolution.

WHEREAS, the attached Fee Schedule for Commercial and Residential activity is considered by the administration as reasonable and justified to keep pace with the rising cost of goods and services incurred by the Municipality with regard to these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Fee Schedule for Commercial and Residential activity set forth in the attachment to this Resolution is hereby adopted.

ADOPTED AS A RESOLUTION at a special voting meeting of the Town Council of the Municipality of Kingston, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, held the 21st day of January, 2025. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
