

**TITLE 6
ANIMAL CONTROL
DISTURBING THE PEACE**

1. Amend Title 6.1.13 to incorporate nuisance disturbing the peace associated with chickens and roosters follows:

- 1 § 6.1.13 Disturbing the peace.
- 2 No owner or responsible party may keep or maintain a pet, hen, or rooster which
- 3 creates a nuisance by continued or repeated barking, howling, yelping, or making of
- 4 other loud or unusual noises for a half hour or intermittently for two hours, and can be
- 5 heard at or beyond the boundary of the property on which the animal is located.
