

ORDINANCE NO. 687

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH GENTRY COUNTY TO COLLECT AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Alderman has determined that it is economically efficient to contract with the County of Gentry for the collection of ad valorem taxes for the City; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary pursuant to Section 70.220 RSMo. To enter into a written agreement with the county for the collection of such taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF KING CITY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The Agreement with Gentry County attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference is approved and the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to sign the same on behalf of the City.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, with the County to begin collection of taxes for the City effective this date until said agreement is terminated according to the terms of the contract.

AN AGREEMENT WITH GENTRY COUNTY  
TO COLLECT AD VALOREM TAXES FOR  
THE CITY OF KING CITY, MISSOURI

THIS AGREEMENT, is entered into as of the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2010, by and between the City of King City, Missouri, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Missouri, hereafter referred to as City, and the County of Gentry of the State of Missouri herein referred to as County.

WITNESSETH:

That the County hereby agrees to maintain on its data system and to collect for the City of King City, Missouri. Ad valorem taxes including current real property, personal property and surcharge taxes beginning with the term of this agreement and shall continue from this day forward, unless one of the parties terminates this contract. A written notice of termination must be received 60 days prior to November 1, the beginning of a tax year, upon the following terms and conditions which the respective parties covenant and agree to keep and perform.

1. The County covenants and agrees:
  - (a) That it will develop tax assessments for all applicable residents of the City of King City.
  - (b) That it will provide to the City a copy a of the original tax print outs, which will include a list of taxpayers, assessments and other pertinent information vital to the tax billing system, if requested.
  - (c) That it will provide to the City a delinquent tax list, if requested.
  - (d) That it will provide to the City a list of any abatements or additions to the tax rolls on a monthly basis, if requested.
  - (e) That it will collect and forward to the City on a monthly basis, any current or delinquent taxes collected by the County and owed to the City.
  
2. The City covenants and agrees:
  - (a) To compensate the County for these services at a rate of one percent (1%) of taxes on the current tax books as of November 1, to be taken out of the December collection each year.
  - (b) To compensate the County Collector for services of collection of all delinquent taxes in that office at a rate of three percent (3%) of the taxes collected and two percent (2%) penalty added on paid by the taxpayer.
