

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RATES CHARGED FOR WATER AND SEWERAGE FURNISHED BY THE CITY OF KING CITY AND REPEALING THAT PART OF ANY ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ORDINANCE #689.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ADLERMEN OF THE CITY OF KING CITY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a review of the present charges for water and sewage by the City indicates that a water rate increase and a sewerage rate increase is necessary and in the best interests of the City, the health and welfare of its citizens because of present water conditions and the increase projected costs of materials and chemicals in the production and supply of water. The increase in sewerage charges is necessary due to the increased costs of maintaining said lines and is further authorized by law.

Section 2: That the following monthly charges shall be made for water furnished by the City of King City:

- (a) Resident consumption
 - (1) First 1,000 gallons or portion thereof \$17.33
 - (2) Over 1,000 gallons \$ 7.88 per 1,000

- (b) Non-resident consumption through waterline connection:
 - (1) First 1,000 gallons or portion thereof \$19.43
 - (2) Over 1,000 gallons \$ 8.93 per 1,000

Section 3: The minimum monthly water charges shall be:

- (a) \$17.33 per city resident connection.
- (b) \$19.43 per non-resident connection.

Section 4: The monthly charge for the sewerage services shall be based upon the total water usage of the individual customer according to the following rates?

- (a) Residential customers
 - (1) A minimum sewerage charge of \$15.75.
 - (2) Over 1,000 gallons/month water usage - \$1.58/1,000 gallons.

Section 5: All provisions of Chapter 700, Article II., Section 700.030 and Chapter 715, Section 715.040 which are not in conflict with this ordinance shall

remain in full force and effect. All ordinances and parts thereof in conflict with these rates are expressly repealed.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect with the July, 2011 billing cycle, meaning for water and sewer sold from and after a customer's meter reading.
