

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF LAUREL SPRINGS,
COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 229-6. of the Code of the Borough of Laurel Springs is amended by the
addition of the following sentence:

It shall be unlawful for any person to remove snow or ice from any driveway, private property, or sidewalk
and place the same onto any sidewalk or the roadway of any street in the Borough of Laurel Springs.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this
Ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistencies, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption, and publication in the
manner prescribed by law.
