Section 1. Add a new Section 76-12.1, entitled "Restrictions, Nuisance Animals" of Article II, entitled "Keeping Animals" of Chapter 76 of the Village Code, entitled "Dogs and Other Animals", as follows (strikethrough indicates deleted language and bold/underlined indicates added language):

§76-12.1 Restrictions, Nuisance Animals

On properties less than ¼ acre in size, the keeping, maintaining or harboring of chickens, roosters, ducks, geese or other fowl or pigeons, is hereby declared a nuisance. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep, maintain or harbor any such animal, or permit any land less than ¼ acre in size owned, occupied or controlled by him or her to be used for such purpose.

Section 2. This local law is determined to be a TYPE II action under the NY State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA").

Section 3. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State.
