AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 440.080 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAKE LOTAWANA REGARDING PARKING STANDARDS

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Lotawana ("City") desires to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Lake Lotawana ("Code"); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the Code to adjust the fines associated with the open storage of inoperable or unlicensed passenger vehicles, watercraft and boat lifes, and inoperable trailers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF LAKE LOTAWANA, MISSOURI, that:

Section 1.

Section 440.080.M.4.c shall be amended as follows:

Offenders shall be given a warning to abate the condition within a time period prescribed by the enforcement officer, not to exceed twenty-one (21) days. Subsequently, a first offense of Section 440.080(M)(4) shall be a fifty dollar (\$50.00) fine, a second offense shall be a one hundred dollar (\$100.00) fine, and third and subsequent offenses shall be a one thousand dollar (\$1,000.00) fine.

<u>Section 2.</u> The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this ordinance shall be severable. In the event that any such section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the remaining portions of this ordinance are valid, unless the court finds the valid portions of this ordinance are so essential to and inseparably connected with and dependent upon the void portion that it cannot be presumed that the City has enacted the valid portions without the void ones, or unless the court finds that the valid portions, standing alone, are incomplete and are incapable of being executed in accordance with the legislative intent.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the applicable laws of the State of Missouri.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
