

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTION 355.110, AND ADOPT A NEW
SECTION 355.110, REGARDING PARKING**

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Waukomis, Missouri previously enacted Section 355.110 but wishes to clarify the Ordinance.

WHEREAS, parking in the City should only be done on prepared surfaces and not in yard areas of homes or on the “shoulder” of the roadways.

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to revise Section 355.110 to reads as follows:

Section 355.110 Parking of Vehicles Within The City Limits.

The parking or storing of cars, trucks, motorcycles, trailers, boats and other vehicles in the yard area of a lot is prohibited. Cars, trucks, motorcycles, trailers, boats and other vehicles can only be parked with all tires/wheels on areas where the surface area has been prepared with concrete, asphalt or properly maintained gravel specifically designed as a parking area. The parking area must be connected to the roadway by a driveway not less than eight (8) feet wide. Cars, trucks, motorcycles, trailers, boats and other vehicles may also be parked with all tires/wheels on the roadway. The owner and/or occupier of the land, and the person who parked on the unprepared surface or off the roadway shall each be responsible for compliance.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE
CITY OF LAKE WAUKOMIS, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:**

Effective September 1, 2025, current SECTION **355.110**, is repealed and NEW SECTION **355.110**, of the Municipal Ordinances of the City of Lake Waukomis is enacted which shall read as follows:

Section 355.110 Parking of Vehicles Within The City Limits.


The parking or storing of cars, trucks, motorcycles, trailers, boats and other vehicles in the yard area of a lot is prohibited. Cars, trucks, motorcycles, trailers, boats and other vehicles can only be parked with all tires/wheels on areas where the surface area has been prepared with concrete, asphalt or properly maintained gravel specifically designed as a parking area. The parking area must be connected to the roadway by a driveway not less than eight (8) feet wide. Cars, trucks, motorcycles, trailers, boats and other vehicles may also be parked with all tires/wheels on the roadway. The owner and/or occupier of the land, and the person who parked on the unprepared surface or off the roadway shall each be responsible for compliance.


