Five Year Capital Improvements Plan FY 24-28

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAVON, TEXAS APPROVING A FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN FOR FISCAL YEARS 2023 TO 2027.

WHEREAS, in 2019, the Planning and Zoning Commission and the City Council engaged a professional planner to obtained and analyze community feedback, host a public design studio, and conduct substantial study that culminated in the 2019 Community Vision Assessment, Strategic Plan and updates to the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, in 2022, the City Council approved an update to the Comprehensive Plan and adopted the Parks and Recreation Master Plan the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, the Strategic Plan was updated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has engaged the services of a professional engineer to work with the staff and City Council to identify, study, and refine the capital needs of the City, prepare cost estimates, guide projects prioritization, undertake preliminary design where feasible and prepare a Five-ear Capital Improvements Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted public hearings on August 1, 2023 and August 15, 2023 to receive input on the proposed Capital Improvements Plan; and

WHEREAS, the approval of a Five-Year Capital Improvements Plan provides a framework to guide staff to plan for right of way acquisition and design that may take time prior to construction and to proceed to schedule approved Capital Improvements.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAVON, TEXAS:

**Section 1.** That the City Council hereby adopts and approves the recitals and findings set forth in the preamble above.

**Section 2.** That the City Council hereby passes this Ordinance approving the Five-Year Capital Improvements Plan for Fiscal Years 2024-2028, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and allocating appropriate funding for the planned projects.

Section 3. That the City Council directs staff to take steps to accomplish the planned projects.

**Section 4.** That the City Council directs that the Five-Year Capital Improvements Plan shall be reviewed annually and that regular reports on project progress shall be provided periodically.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public as required by law and that notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.
