## A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWES, DELAWARE, PROPOSING THAT A PUBLIC HEARING BE HELD ON THE SUBJECT OF A SITE PLAN FOR THE BEACH HOUSE OF LEWES (SP-4-23) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HOTEL, SMALL COMMERCIAL BUILDING WITH SITE IMPROVEMENTS LOCATED AT 209 E. SAVANNAH RD., SCTM: 335-4.20-192.00

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Lewes have deemed it desirable
to consider a Site Plan (SP-4-23 the Beach House of Lewes) for the construction of a new hotel
with a small commercial building with site improvements. The property is located at 209 E.
Savannah Rd. as follows;

WHEREAS, Title 22, Chapter 3, Section 301 of the Delaware Code provides that "[f]or the purpose of promoting health, safety, morals or the general welfare of the community, the legislative body of cities and incorporated towns may regulate and restrict the height, number of stories and size of buildings and other structures, percentage of lot that may be occupied, the size of yards, courts and other open spaces, the density of population, and the location and use of buildings, structures and land for trade, industry, residence or other purposes";

WHEREAS, Section 38 of the City's Charter provides that "[f]or the purpose of protection against fire, promoting health, safety, morals or the general welfare of the community, the City Council is hereby empowered to adopt ordinances to regulate and restrict the height, number of stores [sic], size of buildings and other structures, the density of population and the location and use of buildings, structures and lands for trade, industry, residence or other purposes";

WHEREAS, Article V, Chapter 170, Section 38 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lewes provides the following procedure to be followed by the Mayor and City Council of Lewes before exercising the aforesaid authority granted by statute and the City Charter:

- **A.** Mayor and City Council review. Within 60 calendar days of receiving the Planning Commission's report and recommendations on the site development plan application, the Mayor and City Council shall consider the application at a public hearing.
