ORDINANCE #2024-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND the Code of the City of Lebanon, Chapter 168, Vehicles and Traffic, Section 168-9, One-way streets, in order to designate the northerly 325 feet of Church Street, Lebanon as a one-way street with a northward direction of travel.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, as follows:

Section 1:

The Code of the City of Lebanon is hereby amended to revise Chapter 168, "Vehicles and Traffic", §168-9, One-way streets, for the purpose of adding language referring to Church Street, as follows:

§ 168-9. One-way streets.

Except in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device, no person shall drive a vehicle on the following streets except in the direction indicated:

Name of Street	Direction of Travel	Limits
<u>Church Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Beginning 325 feet south of the intersection of Church Street and South Park Street</u>

Section 2: Severability.

The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable, and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or part thereof is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of any remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance.

Section 3: Effective Date.

The Ordinance shall become effective August 1, 2024.
