Town of LeRay Local Law No. 2 of the year 2022

A Local Law to Amend Chapter 60 of the Code of the Town of LeRay

Be it enacted by the Town/Village Board of the Town of the Town of LeRay as follows:

Section 1. Authority.

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of the New York Municipal Home Rule Law and the New York Town Law.

Section 2. Amendment.

Chapter 60 of the Code of the Town of LeRay is hereby amended as follows:

Section 60-3 D of the Code of the Town of LeRay is amended to read as follows:

D. Fees for Licensing of dogs. The fee for a spayed or neutered dog will be \$12.00 (which includes the assessment of a surcharge of \$1.00 for the purpose of carrying out animal population control), and the fee for unspayed or unneutered dog will be \$22.00 (which includes the assessment of a surcharge of \$3.00 for the purpose of carrying out animal population control), with such fees being reviewed by the Town Board periodically, and such fees may be changed by resolution of the Town Board, if deemed necessary. Replacement tags may be acquired from the Office of the Town Clerk for a fee of \$3.00.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall be effective upon filing with the Secretary of State as required by the Municipal Home Rule Law.
