


CERTIFICATE AND ATTESTATION

ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF LEWISTOWN, MIFFLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CAPTER 60, SALARIES AND COMPENSATION, ARTICLE I, MAYOR; COUNCIL, CONTAINING SEVERABILITY, REPEALER AND SAVINGS CLAUSES.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lewistown has not amended its compensation levels for its elected officials since 1995; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 10, Section 1001(e)(2) and Section 10A04(a)(2) of the Pennsylvania Borough Code (hereinafter referred to as the Borough Code) authorizes the Mayor, President of Council and Members of Council to receive compensation to be fixed by Ordinance at any time and from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 27 of the Pennsylvania Constitution provides: Changes in Term of Office or Salary Prohibited, no law shall extend the term of any public officer, or increase or diminish his salary or emoluments, after his election or appointment, and

WHEREAS, Act 131 of 2024 authorizes Boroughs with a population of Five Thousand (5,000) or more, but less than Ten Thousand (10,000) to pay a maximum annual compensation of \$8,385.00 for the Mayor and a maximum annual compensation of \$4,190.00 for Council Members; and

WHEREAS, Council has a desire to establish an annual compensation for new members of Council and the Mayor, who will be elected during the 2025 election cycle and thereafter and assume office the first Monday in January, 2026 and thereafter.

WHEREAS, this ordinance shall not result in any compensation for Members of Council or the Mayor who are serving under an existing term at the time of the adoption of this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Lewistown, Mifflin County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: Amendment to the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 60, Salaries and Compensation, Article I, Mayor; Council, Section 60-1, Salary of the Mayor. Chapter 60, Salaries and Compensation, Article I, Mayor; Council, Section 60-1, Salary of the Mayor, of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Lewistown is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 60-1. Salary of the Mayor. From and after January 5, 2026, the salary of the Mayor of the Borough of Lewistown shall be \$4,790.00 per calendar year, payable in 12 equal monthly installments.

SECTION 2: Amendment to the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 60, Salaries and Compensation, Article I, Mayor; Council, Section 60-2, Compensation of Councilman other than President of Council. Chapter 60, Salaries and Compensation, Article I, Mayor; Council, Section 60-2, Compensation of Councilman other than President of Council, of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Lewistown is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 60-2. Compensation of Councilman other than President of Council. From and after January 5, 2026, the compensation of each Councilman of the Borough of Lewistown, other than the President of Borough Council, shall be \$4,190.00 per calendar year, payable in 12 equal monthly installments.

SECTION 3: Amendment to the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 60, Salaries and Compensation, Article I, Mayor; Council, Section 60-3, Compensation of the President of Council. Chapter 60, Salaries and Compensation, Article I, Mayor; Council, Section 60-3, Compensation of the President of Council, of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Lewistown is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 60-3. Compensation of the President of Council. From and after January 5, 2026, the compensation of the President of Borough Council, shall be \$4,190.00 per calendar year, payable in 12 equal monthly installments.

SECTION 4: Severability. If any sentence, clause or section or any part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such unconstitutional, illegal and invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof had not been included therein.

SECTION 5: Repealer and Savings. Any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance, or Resolution or part of any Resolution or Motion or part of any Motion conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance or is inconsistent with this Ordinance; otherwise, those provisions of Ordinances, Resolutions or Motions not hereby repealed or amended and not conflicting or not inconsistent herewith are confirmed and incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth.


SECTION 6: Location, Renumbering and Relettering. The location and numerical or alphabetical designation of this Ordinance and the sections and subsections included therein shall be delegated to the discretion of then appointed Codifier of the Code of the Borough of Lewistown (presently the Codifier is "General Code") which may renumber and/or reletter this Ordinance and the sections and subsections therein as are necessary to accommodate this Ordinance in the Code of the Borough of Lewistown. The Codifier shall make no substantive changes to this Ordinance. Any such rearranging, renumbering, relettering and editing shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance or the provisions of the Code affected thereby.

SECTION 7: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately as provided by law.


