A local law to amend Section 80-34.A of the Village Code to allow two (2) hour parking in front of and across from St. Paul's Lutheran Church on Sundays, and to change all references in the Village Code from "Clements Street" to "Edgar Street", since the name of that road was changed.

1. **Purpose**: St. Paul's Lutheran Church has advised the Village Board that the fifteen (15) minute parking restrictions in front of and across from the Church, which is located on Chestnut Street, preclude its parishioners, some of whom are elderly or handicapped, from being able to park adjacent to or immediately across from the Church in order to attend services at the Church on Sundays. The Village Board believes that the present fifteen (15) minute parking restrictions in front of and across from the Church are unnecessary on Sundays and that two (2) hour parking in those locations is appropriate on Sundays. In researching this issue, the Village Board also realized that numerous provisions of the Village Code still reference "Clements Street", when the name of that road (which is the closest intersection to the St. Paul Lutheran's Church and which is referenced in the present fifteen [15] minute parking restrictions being amended) was renamed as "Edgar Street" during the County-wide 911 updates. Accordingly, the Village Board seeks to correct the Village Code to change all present references to "Clements Street" to "Edgar Street".

- 2. All references to "Clements Street" in Sections 18-1.E, 74-21.J, 80-33.A(6), 80-34.A, 80-50, and 80-63 of the Village Code of the Village of Liberty are hereby amended and corrected to refer to "Edgar Street".
- 3. Section 80-34.A of the Village Code of the Village of Liberty is hereby amended to add the following:

"Notwithstanding the foregoing, parking shall be permitted for a maximum of two (2) hours on Sundays on the following portions of Chestnut Street:

(1) The South Side of Chestnut Street in the area between 65 feet west of the intersection of Edgar Street and Chestnut Street and 240 feet West of the intersection of Edgar Street and Chestnut Street; and

(2) The North Side of Chestnut Street, in the area between 80 feet west of the intersection of Edgar Street and Chestnut Street and 185 feet west of the intersection of Edgar Street and Chestnut Street."

4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the New York Department of State.
