AN ORDINANCE AMENDING, ADDING AND REPLACING A SECTION OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LINCOLN PARK, CHAPTER 34, FEES, SECTION 34-8, PARKS AND RECREATION

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lincoln Park desires to amend and update fees for parks and recreation within the Borough of Lincoln Park; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lincoln Park recognizes that the fees have not been amended since 2015; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Lincoln Park, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Chapter 34, Fees, Section 34-8, Parks and Recreation, of the Code of the Borough of Lincoln Park, is hereby amended by amending the following subsections:
