**BOROUGH OF LINCOLN PARK
NOTICE OF INTRODUCTION**

Notice is hereby given that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced to pass on first reading at a meeting of the Council of the Borough of Lincoln Park held on March 18, 2024 and ordered published in accordance with the law. Said Ordinance will be considered for final reading and adoption at a meeting of the Borough Council to be held on April 1, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the Borough Council may hear this Ordinance at the Municipal Building, 34 Chapel Hill Road, Lincoln Park, New Jersey at which time all persons interested may appear for or against the passage of said Ordinance.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING, ADDING AND REPLACING A SECTION OF THE
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF LINCOLN PARK, CHAPTER 34, FEES,
SECTION 34-8, PARKS AND RECREATION**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lincoln Park desires to amend and update fees for parks and recreation within the Borough of Lincoln Park; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lincoln Park recognizes that the fees have not been amended since 2015; and

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Lincoln Park, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Chapter 34, Fees, Section 34-8, Parks and Recreation, of the Code of the Borough of Lincoln Park, is hereby amended by amending the following subsections:

B. Municipal Complex facilities and fields.

(2) Community meeting room at Municipal Complex and/or PAL/Community Center meeting room. An attendant fee may apply based on rental day and time and group utilizing gym and nature of the rental.

G. Recreation.

(1) **Tennis and pickleball:** Membership is combined and shall not be split or pro-rated. Membership is per person per calendar year. Family memberships are not available. Pickleball membership includes indoor playtime from November to March. Outdoor court time is dependent on weather and other Borough schedules. Members are entitled to bring one guest per visit free of charge. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult or guardian 18 or older who is a member.

(2) **Recreation Programs.** Recreation programs are for Lincoln Park residents only unless otherwise listed. Rates for fitness classes will be based on cost of instructor and nature of class and will allow for walk-in fee and discounts for bulk session packages and may vary from year to year. Individual class rates are listed on specific fitness brochures and the Borough website.

SECTION TWO. The Mayor and Borough Clerk, together with all appropriate officers and employees are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate the purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION THREE. All Ordinances of the Borough of Lincoln Park which are

inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION FOUR. If any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
