AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE OF LINCOLN PARK, CHAPTER 450, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SUBSECTION 450-29, CONTROL OF MOVEMENT AND PARKING ON PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTY AUTHORIZING THE ENFORCEMENT OF SUBTITLE 1, TITLE 39 OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO BE APPLIED TO THE MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT KNOWN AS ZELIFF PLACE LOT IN THE BOROUGH OF LINCOLN PARK

WHEREAS, as part of the economic development of the Main Street area in the Borough of Lincoln Park, the Borough has opened a new municipal parking lot at the intersection of Station Road and Zeliff Place (hereinafter known as "Zeliff Place Lot"); and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:4-197 and N.J.S.A. 39:5A-1 authorizes the enforcement of Subtitle 1, Title 39 of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey, the Motor Vehicle and Traffic Statutes, for parking on public property; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer and Borough Attorney have reviewed the final "as built" survey and recommend approval of the application for Title 39 enforcement for the property; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by Governing Body of the Borough of Lincoln Park that Chapter 450-29, Control of movement and parking on public and private property, Code of the Borough of Lincoln Park be amended to add the following hereby amended by adding the following subsections:

SECTION 1: Chapter 450, Vehicles and Traffic, Section 450-29:

A.

- Municipal Lot, Zeliff Place. (11)
- Parking: all vehicles must park in designated area between painted white lines. (a)
- (b) Reserved parking: as per sketch on file in the Borough Clerk's office.
- One-way: as per sketch on file in the Borough Clerk's office. (c)
- (d) No stopping or standing: as per sketch on file in the Borough Clerk's office.
- No parking: as per sketch on file in the Borough Clerk's office. (e)

E. The Zeliff Place Lot is available to the general public for parking from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. everyday. Parking in this lot is limited to patrons and employees of a restaurant located at 211 Main Street from 6:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. everyday. Parking is prohibited for everyone from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. every day. These restrictions are the subject of an easement recorded with the Morris County Clerk's Office on August 6, 2024, Book 24787, Page 1328.

SECTION 2: Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions inconsistent or in opposition to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed in their entirety.
