RESOLUTION NO. 2024-19

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING ON A CERTAIN 2024 CHEVROLET SILVERADO PICKUP TRUCK

WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln Water Department needs a new pickup truck; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price of a new pickup truck for the Water Department is included in the City's 2024 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the specific type of truck to-wit, a Chevrolet Silverado, does not appear on the Arkansas State Vehicle Contract, better known as the "State Bid List"; and

WHEREAS, the specific make and model of pickup truck is best suited to the Lincoln Water Department's needs; and

WHEREAS, Chevrolet of Fayetteville has submitted a proposal to the City of Lincoln to sell the required vehicle to the City for a total purchase price of \$42,651.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds the proposed price to be fair, reasonable and less than the amount appropriated in the budget for the purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: The facts as recited above constitute special, exceptional circumstances justifying a departure from the requirements of ARK. CODE ANN. §14-58-303 and LINC. MUNI. CODE §3.04.02. The City Council hereby finds that under said circumstances, competitive bidding is not feasible or practical, and therefore waives the requirement of competitive bidding under the statute and the ordinance.

Section 2: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Chevrolet of Fayetteville for the vehicle described above. The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized to execute, on the City's behalf, all necessary and incidental documents to effectuate the purchase.
