### ORDINANCE NO. 2024–1032 AN ORDINANCE CREATING 3-3-8 OF THE LINCOLN CITY CODE

THIS ORDINANCE is made and adopted by the CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN, LOGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, at a regular meeting held in the City Council Chambers in said City on the <a href="Isth">15th</a> day of <a href="July">July</a>, 2024, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the CITY OF LINCOLN is a municipal corporation located in Logan County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Liquor Commission for some time has not been issuing any new liquor licenses with gaming, as there has been an effort to reduce the number of gaming terminals in our community to a more manageable level; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is appropriate to codify at this time the maximum number of allowed terminals within the City of Lincoln at 175; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln acknowledges that there are currently approximately 200 gaming terminals being utilized or permitted within the City of Lincoln, and said gaming terminals being currently utilized will remain grandfathered for use within the City of Lincoln;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LINCOLN, as follows:

- 1. That Title 3 Chapter 3 Part 8 of the Lincoln City Code is hereby created to set limits on the amount of video gaming terminals. (See Exhibit A)
- 2. That those currently actively using gaming terminals within their establishments are grandfathered in and will not have their terminals deactivated.
  - a. This protection does not extend to those currently permitted to have gaming machines, but have not activated said machines within their establishments.
- 3. Effective Date. That this Ordinance is effective immediately upon its passage.

# **EXHIBIT A**

## 3-3-8 Number of Licenses

The number of licenses that are available for amusement devices are as follows:

- (A) Video Amusement Device: There is no limit to the number of video amusement device in operation in the city limits at any given time.
- (B) Mechanical Amusement Device: There is no limit to the number of mechanical amusement devices in operation in the city limits at any given time.
- (C) Video Gaming Terminal: There shall be no more than 175 video gaming terminals in operation in the city limits at any given time.
