AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 141
“NOISE”**

SECTION I. Amend Chapter 141, “*Noise*,” to read as follows:

H. Landscaping, Tree services and Property Maintenance.

...

(2) Tree services, which includes tree removal, pruning, trimming and stump grinding, shall only be performed in the Village by a licensed tree service contractor or property owner on the following days and times, excluding federal and New York State holidays:

(a) Permitted hours of operation for tree services:

[1] Property owner:

[a] 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Monday through Friday.

[b] Prohibited on Saturday.

[c] Prohibited on Sunday.

[2] Tree service contractor:

[a] 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

[b] Prohibited on Saturday.

[c] Prohibited on Sunday.


