INC. VILLAGE OF LLOYD HARBOR LOCAL LAW 5-2024 AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 141 "NOISE"

SECTION I. Amend Chapter 141, "Noise," in part, to read as follows:

§ 141-3 Specific noises restricted.

The following acts, without limiting the provisions of § 141-2, are expressly declared to be noises in violation of this chapter if audible at a point 30 feet beyond the property line of the premises or street where such noise is being created:

- Construction and operation of machinery. The construction, demolition, alteration or repair of any building (except interior alterations or repairs to a building which is entirely enclosed) and the operation of large tractors, earthmoving machines, cement mixers, cranes and other similar construction machinery shall only be performed in the Village on the following days and times excluding Sunday, Federal and NYS holidays:
 - 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Monday through Friday. (1)
 - 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. (2)
 - Prohibited on Sunday. (3)
- Landscaping, tree services and property maintenance. H.
 - Landscaping, which includes all lawn and ground maintenance activities, including but not limited to leaf blowers, performed by a paid contractor ("landscaper") or property owner, shall only be performed in the Village on the following days and times, excluding federal and New York State holidays:
 - Permitted hours of operation for landscaping: (a)
 - Property owner: [1]
 - 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Monday through Friday. [a]
 - 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. [b]
 - 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday. [c]
 - Landscaper: [2]
 - 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. [a]
 - 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday. [b]
 - Prohibited on Sunday. [c]

- (2) Tree services, which includes tree removal, pruning, trimming and stump grinding, shall only be performed in the Village by a licensed tree service contractor or property owner on the following days and times, excluding federal and New York State holidays:
- (a) Permitted hours of operation for tree services:
 - [1] Property owner:
 - [a] 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Monday through Friday.
 - [b] 9:00 a.m. to $\underline{4}$:00 p.m. on Saturday.
 - [c] Prohibited on Sunday.
 - [2] Tree service contractor:
 - [a] 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
 - [b] 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday.
 - [c] Prohibited on Sunday.
