

**RESOLUTION 2024-5**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER SOUTHAMPTON, COUNTY OF BUCKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A MUNICIPAL GRANT PROGRAM CONTRACT AWARDED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF BUCKS FOR \$109,968.00.

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Lower Southampton will accept and administer a Municipal Grant Program award for Lower Southampton Township Public Works Department’s Ford F550 Dump Truck with equipment acquisition as approved by the Board of Directors of the Redevelopment Authority of the County of Bucks, herein referred to as the “Authority”, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Lower Southampton agrees to comply with each and every regulation and requirement of Act 71 of 2004, as may be amended from time to time. This Agreement shall be governed by, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Lower Southampton commits to completing the proposed Lower Southampton Township Public Works Department’s Ford F550 Dump Truck with equipment acquisition with due diligence and timing under the terms and conditions set forth by the requirements of the Municipal Grant Programs Act 71 of 2004. If the funds are not expended or the project substantially completed by December 31, 2024 the funding will revert back to the Authority to fund other projects.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lower Southampton:

1. The designated person selected to be the contact for the Municipal Grant Program is Joseph Galdo.
2. The following persons are hereby authorized to sign for and administer the grant funds applied for the Municipal Grant Program Application: Joseph Galdo, Township Manager.
3. The cards with the authorized person’s signature will be included with this Resolution.
