

# Proclamation-Resolution 2026-12

***WHEREAS,** Lower Southampton Township is a Township of the Second Class in the County of Bucks, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, pursuant to the authority vested in it by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lower Southampton does hereby resolve as follows:*

***WHEREAS,** Neshaminy CORE Swimming was established during the winter season of 1997-1998, with ten swimmers participating by the summer of 1998; and,*

***WHEREAS,** the mission of Neshaminy CORE Swimming is to develop goal-driven, team-oriented swimmers within the Neshaminy School District community who strive for excellence in the pool while building the discipline, character, and passion necessary to remain lifelong participants in the sport of swimming; and,*

***WHEREAS,** the vision of Neshaminy CORE Swimming is to serve as a leading developmental swim program within the Neshaminy School District community, preparing athletes for success at the high school, collegiate, and lifelong levels, while fostering a strong team culture and a lasting love for the sport; and,*

***WHEREAS,** Neshaminy CORE Swimming expanded during the 2002–2003 season to more than fifty swimmers and joined the Suburban Aquatics League in Southeastern Pennsylvania; and in 2013, added a USA Masters Program to provide opportunities for adult swimmers; and in 2018, established a spin-off summer team as part of the Lower Bucks Swim League; and,*

***WHEREAS,** Neshaminy CORE Swimming has developed numerous high school athletes who have qualified for PIAA District One Swimming Championships and PIAA State Championships; and,*

***WHEREAS,** many of the athletes have gone on to compete successfully at the collegiate level in NCAA Division I, II, and III, with several holding school records at universities across all three Divisions; and*

***WHEREAS,** Neshaminy CORE Swimming currently serves 125 swimmers in its program; and*

***NOW, THEREFORE,** do we, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lower Southampton, express our sincere appreciation to Neshaminy CORE Swimming for its continued dedication to developing young athletes and strengthening the spirit of community within the Neshaminy School District and Lower Southampton Township.*

***ADOPTED,** by at least a majority of the members of the Board of Supervisors at a duly advertised Public Meeting of the Township on the 8th day of April, 2026 at which a quorum was present.*
