ORDINANCE NO. <u>14</u>-2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOGAN COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 152 ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" TO THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOGAN

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Township of Logan have determined that certain amendments to Chapter 152 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" to add a new Article IV entitled "Truck Route System" are necessary; and

WHEREAS, in all other respects Chapter 152 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" shall remain in full force and effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Logan, in the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1.

Chapter 152 ("Vehicles and Traffic") shall be amended at Article III entitled "Parking":

Article III: Parking.

§ 152-7. Parking prohibited at all times.

A. No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts thereof described as follows:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Heron Drive	<u>Both</u>	<u>From Oldmans Creek Road to High</u> <u>Hill Road</u>
Sharptown Road	<u>Both</u>	<u>From Center Square Road to High</u> <u>Hill Road</u>
Oldmans Creek Road (C.R. 602)	<u>Both</u>	<u>From Pedricktown Road to</u> <u>Township Line Road</u>

Section 2.

Regulatory and warning signs, conforming to the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways shall be erected and maintained to affect the above designated prohibited parking.

Section 3.

Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4.

Repealer.

All prior Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 5.

When effective.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
