**Resolution No. 2023-44
(Duly Adopted August 17, 2023)**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE LOWER MACUNGIE
TOWNSHIP HUNTING AND TRAPPING ON TOWNSHIP
OWNED PROPERTY MAP AND UPDATING THE LIST OF
PARKS WHERE HUNTING AND TRAPPING IS PROHIBITED.**

WHEREAS, Lower Macungie Township adopted Ordinance #2010-11 on October 7, 2010 permitting hunting and trapping on certain Township owned property; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance #2010-11 is codified at Chapter 6, Conduct, Part 2, Hunting and Trapping on Township Lands; and

WHEREAS, Lower Macungie Township adopted a listing of Township Parks, known as "Exhibit 6-2-A," where hunting and trapping is not permitted; and

WHEREAS, Township Code, §6-202 permits Exhibit 6-2-A to be updated from time to time by written resolution of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Lower Macungie Township also identified through the adoption of "Exhibit 6-2-B" Township property which is not part of a Township park where archery hunting is permitted; and

WHEREAS, Township Code, §6-204 permits Exhibit 6-2-B to be updated from time to time by written resolution of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Lower Macungie Township owns hundreds of acres of open space, recreation land, and park land within its Township boundaries that has been modified or added since the adoption of Ordinance #2010-11; and

WHEREAS, Lower Macungie Township as the owner of this property has the right to control the activities on its property as does any other private land owner so long as such control is not imposed in a discriminatory fashion; and

WHEREAS, to be enforceable, maps illustrating hunting and trapping policies of the Township are necessary.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lower Macungie Township:


1. The Lower Macungie Township Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the amended Map entitled "Lower Macungie Township Open Space Safety Zones for Bow & Arrow or Crossbow" attached hereto as Exhibit 6-2-B and incorporated by reference as if set forth in full, for immediate use and regulation to accompany and implement Township Code, Chapter 6, Conduct, Part 2 (Hunting and Trapping on Township Lands).
2. The Lower Macungie Township Board of Commissioners hereby adopts amended Exhibit 6-2-A entitled "Township Parks where Hunting or Trapping is prohibited," attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if set forth in full, for immediate use and regulation to accompany and implement Township Code, Chapter 6, Conduct, Part 2 (Hunting and Trapping on Township Lands).

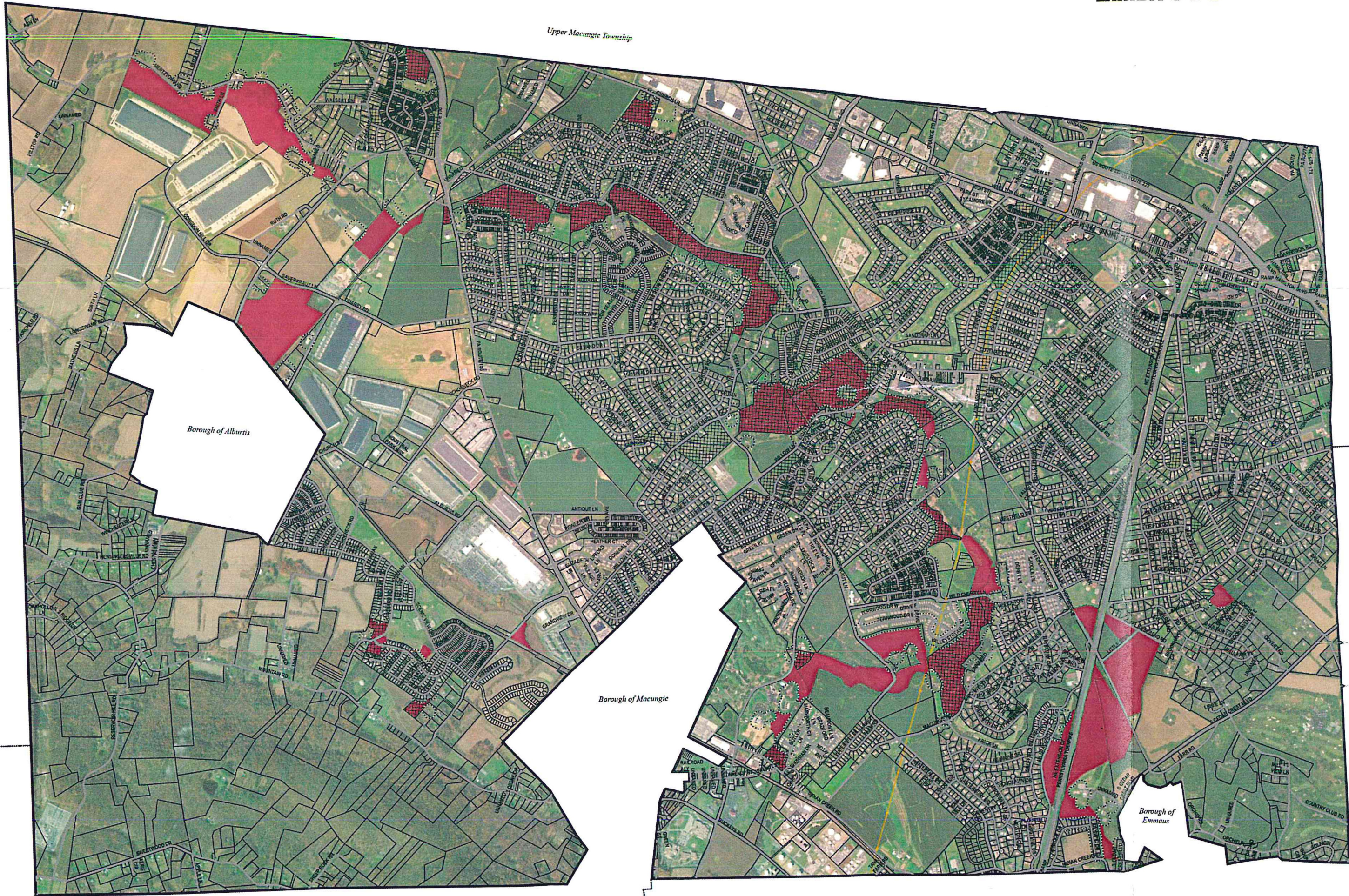
