### **ORDINANCE 24-16C**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LONG BEACH, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 189, WHICH PERTAINS TO VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Long Beach Police Department Traffic Safety Officer recommended the study regarding the installation of stop signs at the intersections of Waverly Avenue and West 83<sup>rd</sup> and 84<sup>th</sup> Streets to protect the public health, welfare, and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the State guidelines and requirements, the Township Engineer conducted a study of the intersections and stop signs and in a report dated May 9, 2024, concluded that the need for the stop signs exists; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon the recommendation of the Police Department and the Township Engineer, the Township has concluded that the installation of the stop signs is necessary and will protect the public health, welfare, and safety.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Commissioners of the Township of Long Beach, Ocean County, State of New Jersey, in accordance with the aforesaid Recitals, which are incorporated herein by reference, as follows.

### STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Chapter 189 to add stop signs to specific intersections.

### **SECTION I**

§189-30B is amended to add the following intersections and stop sign in alphabetical order with the existing locations.

Waverly Avenue and West 83rd Street (Connecticut Avenue) West

West 83<sup>rd</sup> Street (Connecticut

Avenue)

Waverly Avenue and West 84<sup>th</sup> Street (New York Avenue) Avenue) West 84th Street (New York

# **SECTION II**

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinance inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

## **SECTION III**

If any word, phrase, clause, section, or provision of this Ordinance shall be found by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal, or unconstitutional such word, phrase, clause, section, or provision shall be severable from the balance of the Ordinance and the remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

### **SECTION IV**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication thereof after final passage according to law.

### Effective date.

This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication as required by law.
