

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 115 QUALIFICATIONS OF OFFICERS  
ARTICLE I - SECTION 115.010**

**BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOUISIANA, PIKE COUNTY,  
MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:**

**Section 115.010 Qualifications of Officers.**

- A. All officers elected to offices or appointed to fill a vacancy in any elective office under the City government shall be voters under the laws and constitution of this State and, except appointed officers, must be residents of the City. No person shall be elected, or appointed to any office who shall at the time be in arrears for any unpaid City taxes, forfeiture, or defalcation in office.
- B. Officers Defined. The term "officers", whenever used in this Chapter, shall include any person holding any situation under the City Government or any of its departments, with an annual salary, or for a definite term of office, other than clerical or professional staff. Appointed Committee, Commission, or Board members are not considered Officers under this Chapter.
- C. Definitions. As used in this Section, the following terms shall have these prescribed meanings:

**CLERICAL STAFF**

A person or persons employed in a public office, or as an officer of a court, whose duty is to keep records or accounts.

**PROFESSIONAL STAFF**


That person or persons whose knowledge, occupation, instructions, guidance or advisory position with regard to others is of such nature that it renders the person or persons in a unique category not ordinarily classified or available to those persons not already having acquired said skills.
