**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, COUNTY OF OCEAN,  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 2 OF  
THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT"**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, County of Ocean and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 2 of the Township Code entitled "Administration of Government" is hereby amended and supplemented, so as to amend Section 2-26, entitled "Deputy Director of Public Works," which shall read as follows:

**§ 2-26. Chief of Operations.**

The position of Chief of Operations is hereby established for the Township. The Chief of Operations shall be appointed by the Mayor and shall work in conjunction with and support the Director of Public Works for the Township.

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

**NOTICE**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of February 2024, and was then read for the first time.
