

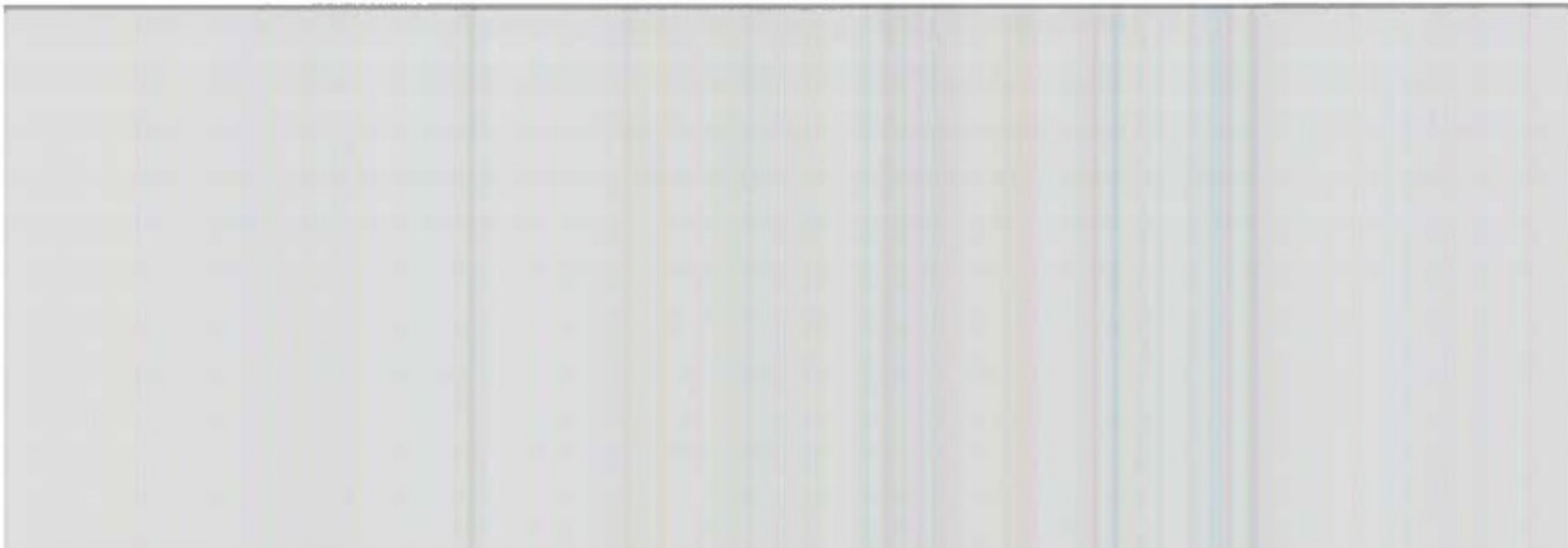

Local Law No. 6 of 2024

A Local Law amending Chapter 7 of the Manorhaven Village Code to add an Alternate Member to the Board of Ethics

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Manorhaven, as follows:

[New Language]

[Old Language]

Section 1. Chapter 7, entitled "Ethics, Code of" of the Village Code is hereby amended as follows:

§ 7-22 Board of Ethics.

(A) There is hereby established a Board of Ethics for the Village. The Board of Ethics shall consist of three **regular** members, appointed by the Village Board of Trustees. **In addition, the Board of Ethics shall have one (1) Alternate Member appointed by the Mayor, subject to approval by the Board of Trustees, who shall serve a one (1) year term. Said Alternate Member shall serve in the place of any regular member of the Board of Ethics that is absent or otherwise unavailable to serve on any particular matter, with the same powers and duties as a regular member of the Board of Ethics.** The members of the Board of Ethics shall receive no salary or compensation for their services as members of the Board of Ethics.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State.

Section 3. Authority.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Manorhaven is authorized to adopt this local law pursuant to Village Law 7-722, as well as Municipal Home Rule Law 10(1)(i) and 10(1)(a)(1).

Section 4. Severability.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
