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Local Law No. 7 of 2024

A Local Law amending Chapter 155 of the Manorhaven Village Code to modify the number of members of the Board of Zoning and Appeals

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Manorhaven, as follows:

[New Language]

[Old Language]

Section 1. Chapter 155, entitled "Zoning" of the Village Code is hereby amended as follows:

- § 155-60 Board of Zoning and Appeals.
 - (A) Creation, selection and organization; establishment and membership.
 - (1) There is hereby reestablished a Board of Zoning and Appeals consisting of seven five (5) members pursuant to the provisions of the Village Law. The Board of Zoning and Appeals in existence on the effective date of this chapter shall continue. Members of the Board of Zoning and Appeals shall be appointed by the Mayor, subject to approval by the Board of Trustees, and shall reside within the Village of Manorhaven. Members shall serve for terms such that one member's term shall expire at the end of the Village official year in which such member was initially appointed; and the remaining members' terms shall be so fixed that one member's term shall expire at the end of each official year thereafter. At the expiration of each original member's appointment, the replacement member shall be appointed for a term of five years. However, the member and Chairman shall be limited to a maximum term of a two-term appointment either consecutive or nonconsecutive over their lifetime. At no point in time may any person serve more than two terms, whether it be consecutive or nonconsecutive terms or appointments, which shall include existing members.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State.

Section 3. Authority.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Manorhaven is authorized to adopt this local law pursuant to Village Law 7-722, as well as Municipal Home Rule Law 10(1)(i) and 10(1)(a)(1).

Section 4. Severability.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and

independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
