

LOCAL LAW 1-2026

A Local Law to Amend Chapter 21 of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck (Ethics, Board of) Regarding Definitions.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mamaroneck as follows:

Section 1.

Chapter 21, § 21-3 of the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck is amended, as follows:

“As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

...

CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Information in any format that is 1) prohibited from disclosure by federal, state or local law or ordinance or by resolution of the Board of Trustees; or 2) exempt from mandatory disclosure under the New York State Freedom of Information Law (FOIL); or 3) not required to be discussed in a public meeting under the New York State Open Meetings Law. Confidential information includes, but is not limited to, nonpublic information such as requests for proposals or bid specifications prior to publication and bids or responses to requests for proposals submitted by persons or business entities.

COVERED PERSON

Members of the Village Board of Trustees, non-union represented department heads, chiefs, officers, consultants/business entities of the Village that provide goods or services to the Village, for which the Village was required to obtain an estimate or to request bids, under existing Village policies, and members of Village agencies, whether compensated or uncompensated, except where otherwise provided in this chapter or by Article 18 of the General Municipal Law. Volunteer firefighters, auxiliary police officers and civil defense volunteers other than Fire Chiefs and Assistant Fire Chiefs are not covered persons.

CUSTOMER/CLIENT

Any person or any business entity to whom or to which a covered person has sold or supplied goods or services to the Village during the previous 12 months having, in the aggregate, a value greater than \$1,000, and any covered person or business entity whose outside employer or business entity has supplied goods or services to the Village during the previous 24 months having, in the aggregate, a value greater than \$1,000, but only if the person knew or had reason to know the outside employer or business entity supplied such goods or services to the Village.

Section 2.

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this local law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, the portion of the law declared to be invalid will be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion and the declaration will not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which will continue in full force and effect.

Section 3.

This law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted by Municipal Home Rule Law § 10(1)(e)(3). It supersedes the provisions of the Village Law, including those provisions which provide for the approval of a land use application on the basis of the passage of time, and the Code of the Village of Mamaroneck, including those provisions which authorize or require the approval of a land use application, to the extent that they are inconsistent with this local law.

Section 4.

This local law will take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law § 27.
