

ORDINANCE NO. 696 OF 2026

**BOROUGH OF MANHEIM
LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RESTATE THE
BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 205
ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", ARTICLE VI
ENTITLED "OFF-STREET UNMETERED PARKING",
SECTION 46 ENTITLED "UNMETERED PARKING LOTS
ESTABLISHED", TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE
WOLF STREET MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT
REGULATIONS AND SUPPLEMENT THE DANNER ALLEY
MUNICIPAL PARKING LOT**

WHEREAS, the Wolf Street Municipal Parking Lot currently has a maximum Parking time of Forty-Eight (48) hours and no regulations for the days or hours of operation;

WHEREAS, the Borough finds that the maximum parking time allowed for the Wolf Street Municipal Parking Lot shall be restricted to between 12:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. daily, except vehicles lawfully parked in designated rental or permit spaces;

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to specify that the Wolf Street Municipal Parking Lot is in operation from 5:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. everyday; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to establish a new unmetered off-street parking lot, referred to as the Danner Alley Municipal Parking Lot.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Manheim, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment to § 205-46. The Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 205, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", Article VI, entitled "Off-Street Unmetered Parking", Section 46, entitled "Unmetered parking lots established", is hereby amended by revising the regulations for the Wolf Street Municipal Parking Lot and adding the Danner Alley Municipal Parking Lot as follows:

Wolf Street Municipal Parking Lot	No parking permitted between 12:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., daily, except vehicles lawfully parked in designated rental or permit spaces	All Days	5:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.
Danner Alley Municipal Parking Lot	No parking permitted between 12:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., daily, except vehicles	All Days	5:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.

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SECTION 2. Signage. The Borough shall install and maintain official traffic control devices providing notice of these restrictions in accordance with applicable law.

SECTION 3. Enforcement. Violations of this Ordinance shall be enforced pursuant to the Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 205, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", Article VI, entitled "Off-Street Unmetered Parking", Section 47 entitled "Unlawful to park overtime or when lot closed." and Section 52 entitled "Violations and penalties."

SECTION 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable. If any provision is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date permitted by law following enactment.
