

ORDINANCE NO. 08-2025

**ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE
TOWN OF MANITOWISH WATERS GENERAL ZONING ORDINANCE 2007-1**

The Town Board of the Town of Manitowish Waters, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Sections 60.10 (2)(c), 62.22, 60.62, 62.23, and 61.35, of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, the Town of Manitowish Waters is authorized to amend and adopt changes to the Manitowish Waters General Zoning Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The Town Board, by the enactment of an ordinance, formally adopted the Town of Manitowish Waters General Zoning Ordinance 86-1 in 1986; updated as 2007-1, adopted June 19, 2007, and as further amended.

SECTION 3. The Manitowish Waters Planning Commission published and posted a Class 2 public notice and held a joint public hearing with the Town Board of the Town of Manitowish Water on October 7, 2025 regarding a proposed Amendment to Article 4.1 of the General Zoning Ordinance that modifies the side yard setback requirements for accessory structures in Single Family Residential.

SECTION 4. The effect of the Amendment shall be to strike Article 4.1(H)(2) and to set the minimum side yard setback for both principal and accessory structures in Single Family Residential at 25 feet.

SECTION 5. The Planning Commission, by majority roll call vote of the Commission at a meeting held on October 7, 2025 recommended to the Town Board the adoption of this proposed Amendment to the General Zoning Ordinance.

SECTION 6. The Town Board of the Town of Manitowish Waters hereby adopts by Ordinance the proposed Amendment to the Town of Manitowish Waters General Zoning Ordinance 2007-1, as Amended.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the full membership of the Town Board, submission to, and approval by, the Vilas County Board of Supervisors, and publication or posting as required by law.
