

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MALDEN, MISSOURI RESTRICTING PARKING ON CERTAIN CITY RIGHTS-OF-WAY ON SMITH STREET, REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Malden, Missouri has determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the safety of the community to restrict parking on certain city rights of way on Smith Street on specified days of the week during specified hours of the day;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MALDEN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking on the City rights-of-way on Smith Street between Morris Street and Downing Street is hereby prohibited and punishable as a minor traffic violation as follows:

- A. Parking on the Western right-of-way (Southbound Traffic) is hereby prohibited Tuesday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 AM and 9:00 AM.
- B. Parking on the Western right-of-way (Southbound Traffic) is hereby prohibited Tuesday through Friday between the hours of 2:00 PM and 4:00 PM.
- C. Parking on the Eastern right-of-way (Northbound Traffic) is hereby prohibited Tuesday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 AM and 9:00 AM.
- D. Parking on the Eastern right-of-way (Northbound Traffic) is hereby prohibited Tuesday through Friday between the hours of 2:00 PM and 4:00 PM.

Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Ordinance, Section 1 of this Ordinance shall not be applicable on any date previously or henceforth designated as a "holiday" by ordinance or other action of the City.

Section 3. At the direction of the City Administrator following consultation with the Superintendent of the Street Department and the Director of Public Safety, the City shall install appropriate traffic control devices, including but not limited to "No Parking" signs designating the restricted days and hours, on the affected portions of Smith Street.

Section 4. That all other Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.


Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and adoption by the City Council of the City of Malden, Missouri and the installation of the approved traffic control devices.
