

BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to the provisions of Section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law, that the Town Board of the Town of Marion has duly held a public hearing on the adoption of the following revised schedule of maximum income eligibility levels for the Town real property tax exemption for persons sixty-five (65) years of age or older;

BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law, that the following schedule of maximum income exemption eligibility levels is hereby approved and adopted:

Annual Income Range	Exemption Percentage
Annual Income Range	Exemption Percentage
\$16,100 or less	50% exemption
More than \$16,100.01, but less than \$17,099	45% exemption
\$17,099, or more, but less than \$18,100	40% exemption
\$18,100 or more, but less than \$19,100	35% exemption
