

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-27

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF
MANTOLOKING, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF
NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 8 “PEACE AND
GOOD ORDER.”**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the governing body of the Borough of Mantoloking, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. The Governing Body hereby amends Chapter 8 “Peace and Good Order” of the Borough Code as follows¹:

§8-5 Miscellaneous Offenses.

...

- g. *Obstruction or Interference with Police. No person in this Borough shall resist, obstruct or interfere with any police officer or any person duly empowered with police authority nor shall any person disobey a lawful order or instruction of any such officer. This includes, but is not limited to, attempting to flee or evade any police officer or any person duly empowered with police authority while in the discharge or apparent discharge of his/her duty.*

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
