ORDINANCE NO. 1178 OF 2026

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MEDIA, COUNTY OF DELAWARE, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 211-3.D OF THE BOROUGH OF MEDIA ORDINANCES TO ADD PORTIONS OF THE FOLLOWING STREETS TO THE RESIDENTIAL PARKING PROGRAM: THE BLOCK OF CHURCH STREET BETWEEN E. JEFFERSON STREET AND E. FRANKLIN STREET AND GAYLEY STREET BETWEEN E. JEFFERSON STREET AND E. FRANKLIN STREET**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Media has determined that residents of certain streets containing a mix of residential and commercial and/or office uses face substantial difficulties in obtaining on-street parking in proximity to their residences; and

**WHEREAS**, a residential permit parking program was therefore created and codified at Chapter 211 of the Code of the Borough of Media; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that portions of certain streets should be added to the Borough's residential parking program area in order to facilitate more available parking within the Borough for residents of streets containing a mix of residential and commercial and/or office uses.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1: Amendment of Section 211-3.**

**(B) Amendment of Section 211-3(B)(3) to designate additional residential parking space on Church Streets and Gayley Streets.** Section 211-3(B)(3) of the Code of the Borough of Media is hereby amended by adding the following street to the residential parking program:

- “(k) the west side of Church Street between E. Jefferson Street and E. Franklin Street.
- (l) the west side of Gayley Street between E. Jefferson Street and E. Franklin Street.”

**Section 2: Severability:** The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions thereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the Court shall

not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted as if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions had not been included therein.

**Section 3: Saving Provision:** Nothing in this Ordinance, as hereby amended, shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding in any Court, and rights acquired or liability incurred, any permit issued, or any cause or causes of action existing under this Ordinance prior to the adoption of this amendment.

**Section 4: Immediate Effect:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval of this amendment.
