510-17. Municipal parking lots.

A. Pursuant to § 510-5 of this chapter, the Mayor may establish regulations for the use, maintenance and operation of municipal parking lots owned or operated by the Village of Mineola, hereinafter designated as follows:

- (1) Parking Field No. 1: located at the west side of Third Avenue and east of Winthrop Hospital.
- (2) Parking Field No. 2: located on Hopkins Avenue off Willis Avenue
- (3) Parking Field No. 3: located at the parking garage on Third Street, east of Mineola Boulevard.
- (4) Parking Field No. 4: located at the parking garage on First Street and Main Street.
- (5) Parking Field No. 5: located at the northeast corner of First Street and Third Avenue (Harrison Avenue Parking Garage).
- (6) Parking Field No. 5A: located on First Street.
- (7) Parking Field No. 6: located on Washington Avenue and Willis Avenue.
- (8) Parking Field No. 7: located at the north side of LIRR south of Field No. 1 (west side of Third Avenue and east of NYU Winthrop Hospital).
- (9) Parking Field No. 8: located at the southeast corner of Mineola Boulevard and Banbury Road.
- (10) Parking Field No. 9: located at the south side of Jericho Turnpike between Wardwell Road and Beebe Road.
- (11) Parking Field No. 10: located at the south side of Jericho Turnpike between Latham Road and White Road.
- (12) Parking Field No. 11 – Village Hall /Community Center on Washington Avenue
- (13) Parking Field No. 12: located at the north side of Washington Avenue, west of the Fire Department Headquarters
- (14) Parking Field No. 13: located at Wilson Park west of Pony Field off Union Street.
- (15) Parking Field No. 14: located at Little League parking field.
- (16) Parking Field No. 15: located at the southeast corner of Elm Place and Lincoln Avenue.
- (17) Parking Field No. 16: located at the Pershing Parkway field (one block south of Jericho Turnpike).
- (18) Parking Field No. 17: located on Washington Avenue to Jericho Turnpike, west of Fire Department Headquarters
- (19) Parking Field No. 18: located on Westbury Avenue east of Senior Citizens Center, Wilson Park.
- (20) Parking Field No. 19: located on Jericho Turnpike between Fire Department Headquarters and Parking Field No. 17.
- (21) Parking Field No. 20: located on the Mineola Memorial Library parking field.
- (22) Parking Field No. 21: located at the south side of Jericho Turnpike east of the Fire Department Headquarters.
- (23) Parking Field No. 22: located at the northeast corner of Elm Place and Clinton Avenue.
- (24) Parking Field No. 23: located at the south side of Second Street between Main Street and Willis Avenue.
- (25) Parking Field No. 24: located at the south side of Second Street at Roslyn Road.
- (26) Parking Field No. 25: located at the north side of Third Street at Willis Avenue.
- (27) Parking Field No. 26: located on west side of Main St. Opposite of 70 Main St.

B. Commuters' parking fields.

- (1) In any commuters' parking field or part of a parking field set aside and marked as a commuters' parking field, no person or persons shall enter, park or permit to remain standing, attended or unattended, any automobile or other vehicle unless such persons shall be residents of the Village of

Mineola and shall have first obtained from the Village Clerk of the Village of Mineola a commuter parking permit.

(2) Commuters' parking fields shall include the following:

1. Parking Field No. 1: located at the west side of Third Avenue and east of NYU Winthrop Hospital.
2. Parking Field No. 3: located at the parking garage on Third Street, east of Mineola Boulevard.
3. Parking Field No. 7: located at the north side of LIRR south of Field No. 1 (west side of Third Avenue and east of Winthrop Hospital).
4. Station Rd: Between 5th Avenue and 8th Avenue.

(3) Fees for commuters' parking field licenses shall be in an amount determined from time to time by resolution of the Board of Trustees.

(4) Any violation of this subsection shall result in a minimum fine of \$75.

C. Parking Field No. 9 and No. 10

- (1) Head in Parking Only
- (2) There is a ten-hour limit on parking of vehicles between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- (3) No commercial vehicles are permitted.

D. Parking Field No. 14. Eight of 10 commuter parking spaces are changed to special parking permits in Field No. 14.

E. Commercial parking prohibited in Parking Field Nos. 17 and 21. No commercial parking shall be permitted in Parking Field Nos. 17 and 21.

F. This subsection authorizes the posting of "No Commercial Vehicle Parking" in Parking Field No. 6 (Washington & Willis).

G. Village Hall/Community Center west parking lot. Regulations shall be as follows: "Parking for Village business only. Limit two hours, Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m."

H. Use of Parking Lots for Storage.

- (1) Use of the Village parking lots to store vehicles or equipment is strictly prohibited.
- (2) Vehicles or equipment parked in any parking lot in excess of three (3) consecutive days shall constitute storage.
- (3) Vehicles parked in any parking lot in excess of three (3) consecutive days, without obtaining a parking permit from the Village Parking Supervisor, shall be subject to parking violations and possible towing and storage charges.
- (4) Vehicles with a parking permit are required to comply with all rules, regulations, ordinances and directives of the Village and the Village Parking Supervisor. From time to time, permit holders may be required to remove vehicles from the Village parking lot at the direction of the Village Parking Supervisor.
