WHEREAS, the City of Middletown has been presented with a proposal for a health and fitness facility in the C-3 General Business zoning district, and

WHEREAS, this particular use is currently allowed in the DMU, Limited General Business, Light Industrial, and Light Industrial/General Business zoning districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AND BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Middletown, as follows:

Section 1. The Code of the City of Middletown, N.Y., Chapter 123, Zoning, as adopted March 27, 1967 and amended, be and is hereby further amended by adding a new Paragraph (26) to Subsection B, Uses requiring issuance of both a special use permit and site plan approval by the

Planning Board, to read as follows:

(26) Health club or fitness facility which may include such facilities as weight-lifting equipment; indoor running tracks; swimming pools; tennis, squash or racquetball courts; exercise machines, such as treadmills and rowers; skating, roller or boxer rinks; and accessory facilities such as saunas, showers and locker rooms, but excluding any facility involving the use or discharge of firearms.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
