LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 2022

A Local Law to Add a New Chapter 41 Entitled "Residency Requirements" to the Village Code to Allow Certain Public Officers and Employees to be Residents of Dutchess County, NY

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Millerton as follows:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

The Board of Trustees finds that, due to the relatively small population of the Village of Millerton, it is not always possible to fill certain positions in Village government requiring municipal, administrative or financial expertise with Village residents who are duly qualified to hold such positions. The Board further finds that it is authorized under § 3-300 of the New York Village Law and § 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law to expand such residency requirements to allow residents of Dutchess County to be eligible for said positions.

SECTION 2. CODE AMENDMENT

A new Chapter 41, entitled "Residency Requirements" shall be added to the Village Code, which shall read as follows:

Section 41-1. Village Clerk. Notwithstanding any other general or special law, a person shall be eligible to be appointed to the position of Village Clerk if such person is a resident of Dutchess County, New York, in which the Village of Millerton is located.

Section 41-2. Treasurer. Notwithstanding any other general or special law, a person shall be eligible to be appointed to the position of Village Treasurer if such person is a resident of Dutchess County, New York, in which the Village of Millerton is located.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this local law are severable. If any provision of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm, corporation, or circumstance is adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order or judgment shall not affect or impair the validity of the other

provisions of this local law or the application thereof to other persons and circumstances.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Municipal Home Rule Law § 27(1).
