VILLAGE OF MIDDLEPORT

COUNTY OF NIAGARA, STATE OF NEW YORK

A Local Law Amending the Water Service Termination and Reconnection Fees with in the Village of Middleport

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Middleport as follows:

Village code, Chapter 196 Water, §196-10.2 shall be repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

§ 196-10.2 Termination and Reconnection Fees.

Whenever water service shall have been terminated pursuant to this Article or for any other reason, including request of the owner of the premises, a fee in an amount to be determined by resolution of the Village Board of Trustees, in accordance with the fee schedule under this Article, shall be paid (i) at the time of the termination of water service, and (ii) prior to the restoration of water service, to cover the expenses incurred by the Village to terminate and restore services.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon the filing with the Secretary of State.
