RESOLUTION NO. 2024-4

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE BOROUGH MANAGER TO REGULATE VEHICULAR TRAFFIC DURING CONSTRUCTION WORK IN 2024.

WHEREAS, this Borough has commenced a project to make certain improvements to its public sewer system (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Project will at times require the closure of streets on a temporary basis during construction work; and

WHEREAS, Section 350-6.D of the Code of Ordinances provides that upon resolution by Council the Borough Manager shall have the authority to regulate vehicular traffic in a manner deemed appropriate during construction work on a street or adjacent properties; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to grant the Borough Manager such authority during the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by Borough Council of the Borough of Millersville, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. In accordance with Section 350-6.D of the Code of Ordinances, Council grants the Borough Manager the authority to regulate vehicular traffic including, but not limited to, closing of streets, re-routing of traffic, stationing of flaggers, or other appropriate forms of traffic control or regulation, in connection with the Borough’s project to make improvements to the public sewer system. The Borough hereby expressly approves the traffic plan for the temporary closures of streets including, but not limited to, Charlotte Street, for periods not in excess of seven (7) consecutive days. Council further expressly approves any actions concerning the posting of signs and other notices to alert drivers to the location of temporary street closures and detours.

Section 2. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Resolution, it being the intent of Borough Council that the remainder of the Resolution shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately.
