

**TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN  
ORDINANCE NO. 2641-23**

**CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND ACQUISITIONS IN, BY AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP, APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$2,202,000 AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH SUM SO APPROPRIATED SHALL BE RAISED FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE TOWNSHIP AND FROM THE TOWNSHIP'S CAPITAL RESERVE FOR POLICE AND CAPITAL RESERVE FOR DPW**

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Millburn, in the County of Essex, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Township of Millburn, in the County of Essex, New Jersey (the "Township") is hereby authorized to make the following public improvements and acquisitions in, by and for the Township, including all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor:

(A) Fire Department

Undertaking of various improvements to Fire Headquarters and Fire Station No. 2, including, but not limited to: (i) HVAC improvements; (ii) installation of security cameras; and (iii) various interior and exterior renovations.

Estimated Cost: \$175,000

(B) Department of Public Works

Acquisition of new additional or replacement equipment and machinery and new automotive vehicles, including original apparatus and equipment, and undertaking of various improvements, including, but not limited to: (i) acquisition of a tree bucket truck, a stump grinder trailer, a sidewalk plow and a multi-use utility truck with attachments; and (ii) undertaking of sewer improvements on Main Street.

Estimated Cost: \$777,000

(C) Police Department

Undertaking of various improvements and acquisition of new communication and signal systems equipment, including, but not limited to: (i) installation of LED lighting at Police Headquarters and installation of security cameras and emergency phones at the Parking Deck; and (ii) acquisition of a mobile video recorder.

Estimated Cost: \$175,000

(D) Recreation

Undertaking of various improvements to public property, including, but not limited to: (i) refurbishing the tennis courts at Taylor Park; (ii) construction of pickleball courts at Gero Park; and (iii) conversion to LED lighting at Gero Park.

Estimated Cost: \$425,000

(E) General Building Improvements

(i) Undertaking of improvements to various public buildings and (ii) installation of pedestrian safety and street signs at various locations.

Estimated Cost: \$250,000

(F) Engineering

Undertaking of various improvements, including, but not limited to: (i) drainage improvements at various locations; and (ii) access road and security improvements at the Slayton Pump Station.

Estimated Cost: \$400,000

Section 2. The sum of \$2,202,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of the improvements and acquisitions authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township and from the Township's Capital Reserve for Police and Capital Reserve for DPW, as hereinafter provided. The sum of \$1,430,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township to the payment of the cost of said purpose. The sum of \$275,000 is hereby appropriated from the Township's Capital Reserve for Police to the payment of the cost of said purpose. The sum of \$497,000 is hereby appropriated from the Township's Capital Reserve for DPW to the payment of the cost of said purpose.

Section 3. Said improvements and acquisitions are lawful capital improvements of the Township having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements and acquisitions shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Township Clerk and is available for public inspection.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.
