

**TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN-
ORDINANCE NO. 2661-24
AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTER 2-33 "SHADE TREE ADVISORY BOARD"**

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE: *the purpose of this Ordinance is to repeal Chapter 2-23 "Shade Tree Advisory Board" from the Township's code. The Township wishes to reconstitute the Shade Tree Advisory Board by resolution, consistent with other Advisory Boards and Committees. The repeal of Chapter 2-33 is not to eliminate the Township's Shade Tree Advisory Board, but to add additional flexibility to the way Millburn Township addresses boards and committees.*

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Millburn wishes to reconstitute the way members of the Shade Tree Advisory Board are appointed; and

WHEREAS, the repeal of this ordinance will be followed by a resolution before the Township Committee to consider reestablishing how the Shade Tree Advisory Board is constituted and functions going forward; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Millburn in the County of Essex and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1 Article 2-33 "SHADE TREE ADVISORY BOARD", is hereby repealed in its entirety as shown by deleting existing text as per ~~strike throughs~~.

~~A citizens' advisory committee to be known as the Shade Tree Advisory Board is established to assist and advise the Township Committee, the Superintendent of Public Works and the Forester with respect to the planting, care and control of trees and shrubbery in public places owned, leased or managed by the Township. The Board shall consist of five (5) persons appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Township Committee. The term of each member shall be three (3) years~~
