TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN ORDINANCE NO. 2675-24

CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MILLBURN, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX, NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND ACQUISITIONS IN, BY AND FOR THE TOWNSHIP, APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$1,712,000 AND PROVIDING THAT SUCH SUM SO APPROPRIATED SHALL BE RAISED FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE TOWNSHIP AND FROM THE TOWNSHIP'S CAPITAL RESERVE FOR POLICE AND CAPITAL RESERVE FOR DPW

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Millburn, in the County of Essex, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Township of Millburn, in the County of Essex, New Jersey (the "Township") is hereby authorized to make the following public improvements and acquisitions in, by and for the Township, including all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor:

(A) Fire Department

Undertaking of various improvements to Fire Headquarters and Fire Station No. 2 and acquisition of new additional or replacement equipment and machinery, including, but not limited to: (i) replacement of the generator at Fire Station No. 2; and (ii) acquisition of rescue struts and self-contained breathing apparatus equipment.

Estimated Cost: \$185,000

(B) Department of Public Works

Acquisition of new additional or replacement equipment and machinery and new automotive vehicles, including original apparatus and equipment, including, but not limited to: (i) a sewer flusher; (ii) a wood chipper; and (iii) multi-use trucks with attachments.

Estimated Cost: \$662,000

(C) Police Department

Undertaking of various improvements and acquisition of new additional or replacement equipment and machinery, including, but not limited to: (i) acquisition of license plate reader equipment; and (ii) installation of building signage at Police Headquarters.

Estimated Cost: \$125,000

(D) Recreation

Undertaking of various improvements to public property, including, but not limited to: (i) replacement of pumps at the Millburn Municipal Pool; (ii) HVAC improvements at the

Bauer Center; (iii) construction of an inclusive playground at Taylor Park; and (iv)

conversion to LED lighting at Gero Park (Phase 2).

Estimated Cost: \$440,000

(E) **General Building Improvements**

Undertaking of improvements to various public buildings.

Estimated Cost: \$100,000

(F) Engineering

Undertaking of various improvements, including, but not limited to: drainage

improvements at various locations.

Estimated Cost: \$200,000

Section 2. The sum of \$1,712,000 is hereby appropriated to the payment of the cost of

the improvements and acquisitions authorized and described in Section 1 hereof (hereinafter referred to

as "purpose"). Said appropriation shall be raised from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township

and from the Township's Capital Reserve for Police and Capital Reserve for DPW, as hereinafter provided.

The sum of \$1,517,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund of the Township to

the payment of the cost of said purpose. The sum of \$100,000 is hereby appropriated from the

Township=s Capital Reserve for Police to the payment of the cost of said purpose. The sum of \$95,000 is

hereby appropriated from the Township=s Capital Reserve for DPW to the payment of the cost of said

purpose.

Section 3. Said improvements and acquisitions are lawful capital improvements of the

Township having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements and acquisitions shall

be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially

benefited.

Section 4. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this

capital ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith and the resolutions promulgated by the

Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved

by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Township Clerk and is available

for public inspection.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take	se effect at the time and in the manner provided
